How to Report a Crime...

If you witness a crime in progress, or one that has just occurred, you need to call the police. Identify yourself as a Neighborhood CrimeWatch Member and provide the following information:

- Your Name
- Your Address
- Your Telephone Number

Be sure to stay on the line until the police have all the information needed.

What Facts to Remember...

The police will ask you to REMEMBER these important crime facts:

- Nature of Incident
- Location of Occurrence
- Description of Offender(s)
- Nature of Injuries
- Method of Escape
vehicle, walking, running
- Direction of Travel
if a vehicle is involved, get the license plate number and description if possible

Do I always call Emergency 911 to report a crime?

No. It's important for you to be able to distinguish between a Priority One Call (Emergency 911) and a Priority Two Call (Non-Emergency). See the examples below:

Emergency 911 Calls

Priority One Calls: Emergency Call 911

- Rape in progress or just occurred
- Robbery in progress or just occurred
- Burglary in progress or just occurred
- Shootings
- Motor vehicle accidents with injuries
- Fight or disturbances in progress WITH weapons

Non-Emergency Calls

Priority Two Calls: Call (972) 744-4800

- Motor vehicle accident, no injuries
- Criminal mischief
- Public intoxication
- Stalled vehicle blocking traffic
- Fight or disturbances in progress
